The facility has seasonal slips for 106 boats, limited transient space for boats of up to 65 feet, and winter storage for over 200 vessels. Slips have 24/7 WiFi access and are equipped with 50-amp electrical service and water. Head, shower, laundry and pump out facilities are available. We also have a ramp for hydraulic trailer launching.

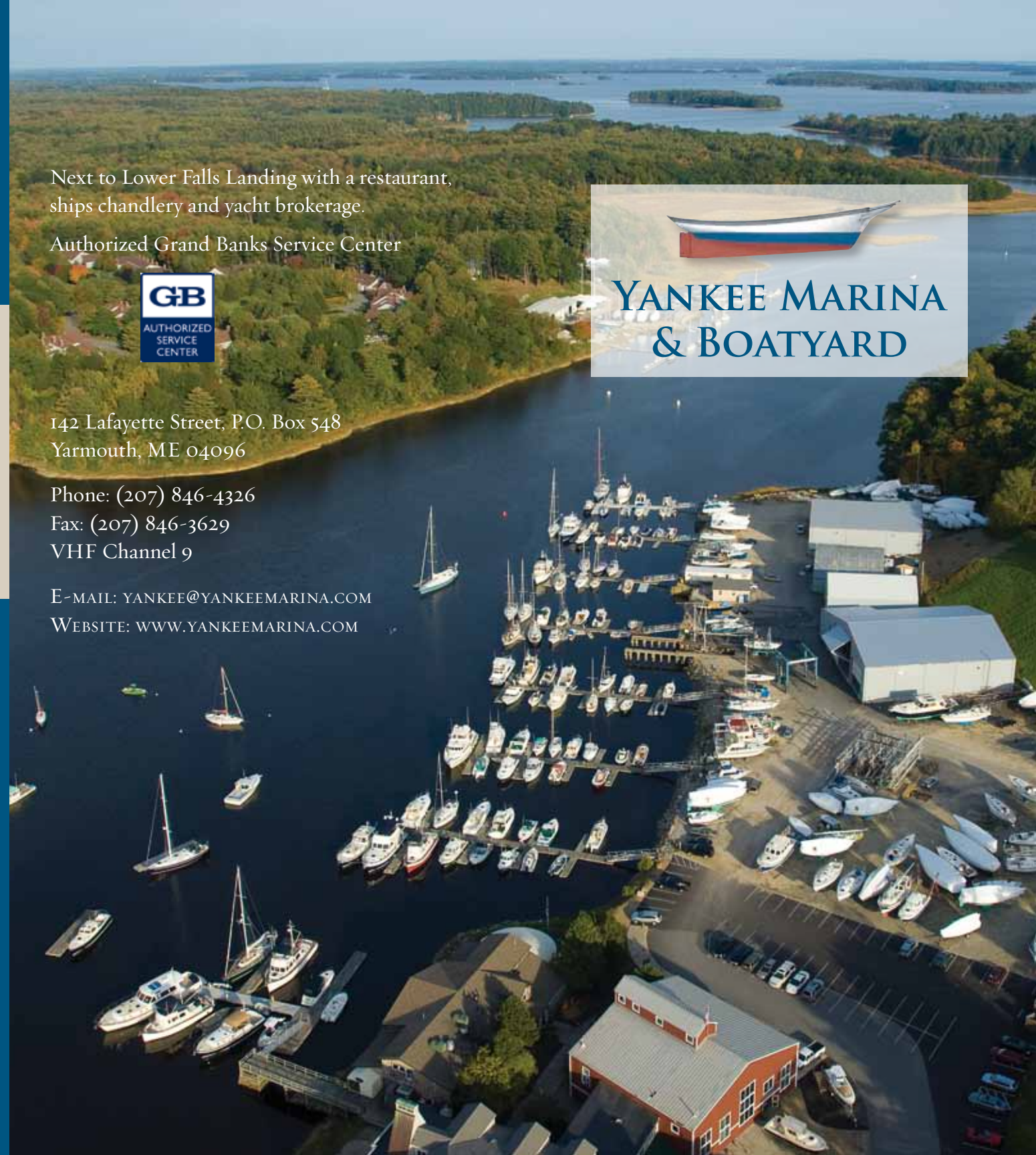
